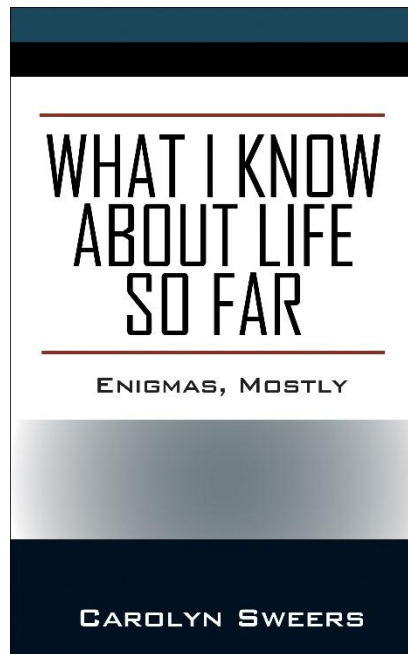


Top 5 Interview Questions for *What I Know About Life So Far* by Carolyn Sweers
