


Top 5 Interview Questions for *Old Books and Faded Dreams* by D. L. Norris

4. Your novels often blend humor, nostalgia, and emotional depth. How do you find that balance in your storytelling, and what elements of your Scandinavian family culture inform this style?
5. Without giving away spoilers, the book contains a significant revelation hidden for decades. What fascinates you about generational secrets, and why do you think they resonate so powerfully with modern readers?
